Using a codicil to add a gift to your Will

A codicil is a supplement to a Will, which makes an alteration but leaves the rest of the Will intact and valid. It can be useful when adding a new cash gift to an individual or charity.

There is no limit to the number of codicils that can you add to a Will, but they are only suitable for simple additions.

If you have several changes to make, or wish to change the residuary gifts in your Will, we recommend you consult a solicitor for advice. See our Free Will offers page to find a solicitor to help with this.

You can use the codicil form below to add a simple cash gift to the Macular Society to your existing Will, or ask your solicitor to do it for you.

The codicil must be completed, signed and witnessed by two people in England and Wales, one only if you are in Scotland. Your witnesses must see you sign the document and then sign it themselves. The codicil must be kept with your original Will so it can be located easily. Please do not send it to the Macular Society.
